### **Objectives**

In recent years, public and private organizations have faced volatility, uncertainty, lack of stability, pandemic challenges, geopolitical disruptions, energy crises, etc. In turbulent conditions, organizations have to deal with and manage multiple challenges, such as securing public health, maintaining economic vitality, steering uncertainty and instability in society, ensuring national security defense, and securing efficient navigation of the disruption. It is evident, some organizations are proactive and able to prepare and adapt adequately to the rapidly changing environment. In contrast, others struggle, which unequivocally affects the strategic directions. Hence, our goal is to examine a resilient organization's traits, features, and aspects and explore its interconnections with other areas, including but not limited to digitalization, quality of services, growth potential, sustainability, etc.
